



Parade Driver Instructions

1. Your float number must be displayed and visible on the front of your vehicle so judges know which entry you are. **This is not your place in line, just your announcer number.**
2. **No Santa's on Floats.** Santa rides at the end of the parade and is provided by the parade committee. **Please honor this.**
3. Please make sure all participants, vehicles, and floats remain on Midland Ave. No vehicles or floats may be on Hwy 67 during line-up.
4. Once you are in line for the parade, **please do not leave your vehicle unattended.** We may need you to move forward a little to accommodate other entries. If your driver has to leave, ***YOU MUST POST THEIR PHONE NUMBER ON THE WINDOW SO WE CAN CALL IF YOUR ENTRY NEEDS TO BE MOVED.*** This was a real mess last time. Please help us.
5. While waiting for the parade to begin, keep participants on your float or directly behind it.
6. **We must finish the parade in one hour (CDOT requirement.)** Be ready to start at 5:45 PM. Judges are walking the parade line up starting at 5 PM before the parade begins, so give them something to look at and a reason to vote for your entry!
7. **THERE ARE A LOT OF ENTRIES THIS YEAR!!! Please keep no more than two car lengths from the vehicle/float in front of you at all times. There will be spotters along the route.**
8. Walkers with floats must hand out candy –
NO THROWING- Read this again- NO THROWING OF CANDY!!!
Violators will be asked to assist with clean up after the parade and/or denied entry next year or shot on sight. We're serious. Please help us keep the parade route clean and safe for our kids. **Please, continue moving when the fireworks begin. Do not stop your entry to watch.** The parade route continues past Tweeds. Do not try to turn on Fairview. Please continue down Laurel St and head north. **Someone ran into cars on Henrietta so you cannot go back west on Henrietta this year.** Head towards the High School to meet up after the parade this year or continue on Laurel to Boundary and then back west on Lake Ave. This is at the request of WPPD.
